

Conecuh Shooting Range

Range Rules

- Conecuh Shooting Range is managed under a partnership between USDA Forest Service—Conecuh National Forest, and Alabama Division of Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries.
- The range is open during daylight hours only, sunrise to sunset.
- Shooters under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- All firearms must be open and unloaded when entering or exiting the range.
- Load firearms only when you are at the firing line, downrange is clear, and you are ready to shoot.
- Always point the muzzle of your firearm in a safe direction.
- Shoot only from the firing line, downrange and at targets.
- Shoot only at the target directly in line with your position, never across the range.
- Use stationary paper targets only. Please don't use bottles, cans, or other breakable targets.
- Shotguns using no. 4 shot or smaller may be fired at moving clay targets on the designated clay area only.

- No armor-piercing, tracer, or incendiary type ammunition is allowed.
- Be sure that everyone's firearms are unloaded and grounded (laid down) before anyone goes downrange.
- Spectators must remain behind shooting benches during any shooting activity.
- Limit your time to one hour or less per shooter if others are waiting to shoot.
- Properly dispose of all litter.
